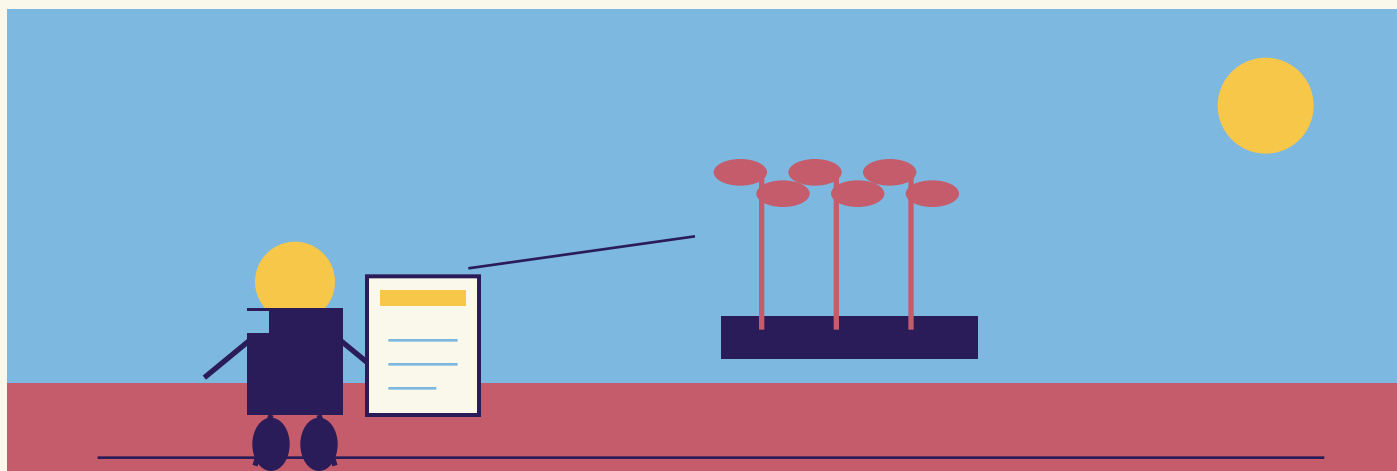


Garden Seeds: Look, Notice, Wonder
